Featured Crime – Circle K Robbery

Licking County Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of those responsible for robbing a convenience store in Newark.

Police report on Oct. 9 a man walked into the Circle K convenient store at 599 W. Main St., brandished a knife, and got away with an undisclosed amount of cash and other merchandise. The robber is described as a black man, approximately five-foot-eight to six-feet tall, in his twenties to early thirties, wearing a dark and light blue hooded sweatshirt.

A special coding system protects the identity of the caller but allows for the reward to be issued at a later time. If the caller testifies at grand jury the reward may be doubled.

Crime Stoppers also takes calls from persons with information about any felony. Information leading to the arrest and indictment of a felony suspect could qualify the caller for a reward as determined by the Crime Stoppers' Board. Crime Stoppers is a non-profit organization. Reward money comes from private individuals, businesses, and foundations that see Crime Stoppers as an integral tool in the community's fight against crime.
